



# Activity For Kids: CHALK SHADOW SHAPES

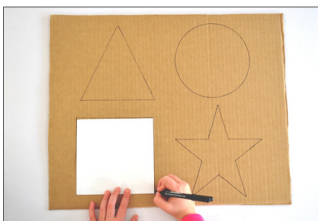
Enjoy the spring sunshine and learn about shapes with this fun activity.

## YOU'LL NEED...

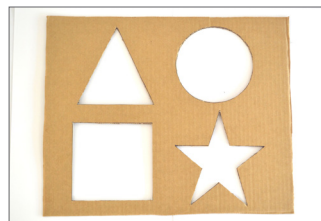
- Micador early stART Egg Chalk
- Micador painting paper
- Micador stay anywhere permanent pen
- Micador Sizzle Scissors or a sharp blade
- A piece of cardboard such as a recycled box or thick card



## Let's start...



**1.** Use your marker pen to draw some shapes on a piece of the painting paper. Cut your shapes



**2.** Cut your shapes out from the cardboard.



**3.** Take your shape board out into the sunshine and make some shadows! Trace your shapes on different surfaces - it washes off really easily!



**4.** Decorate and colour your shapes.

## TIPS:

- We drew a square, circle, rectangle and a star. You could draw more challenging shapes such as pentagons and hexagons for older children.
- Extend this activity by placing your card on different angles to see how the shadows change size and shape.
