

Activity For Kids: CHALK SHADOW SHAPES

Enjoy the spring sunshine and learn about shapes with this fun activity.

YOU'LL NEED ...

- · Micador early stART Egg Chalk
- · Micador painting paper
- · Micador stay anywhere permanent pen
- · Micador Sizzle Scissors or a sharp blade
- · A piece of cardboard such as a recycled box or thick card



Let's start...



Use your marker pen to draw some shapes on a piece of the painting paper. Cut your shapes

Cut your shapes out from the cardboard.

Take your shape board out into the sunshine and make some shadows! Trace your shapes on different surfaces - it washes off really easily!



Decorate and colour your shapes.

TIPS:

- · We drew a square, circle, rectangle and a star. You could draw more challenging shapes such as pentagons and hexagons for older children.
- · Extend this activity by placing your card on different angles to see how the shadows change size and shape.
