

Brilliant Watercolour Beetroot

Use the supplied template to help you paint this rich beetroot piece.

You will need:

- Brilliant Watercolour Discs, 36
- Roymac Rigger Brush, Size 8
- Rains Watercolour Paper
- Water
- Paper Towel
- Pencil
- Eraser



Tips:

 Have fresh water on hand to ensure you have a clean brush when required









Step 4:

Step 1: Draw outline

beetroot.

NOTE: You can trace the wet" technique. PDF download or draw freehand depending on your confidence and skill level.

Step 2: Wet paper

Use a pencil to draw your Wet the leaves with water to prepare for a "wet-on-

Step 3: View wet paper Leaves

Hold your paper up to a natural light source. This will enable you to ensure you have wet all the required areas.

Using 'apple green', 'moss green' and 'sap green' on Disc 2, paint your leaves. You will notice the colours blend well because the paper is wet.

Step 5: Beetroot

Using the same technique as the leaves, wet the beetroot area with clean water first. Then add 'red' and 'burgundy' from Disc 3 to create the edges of your beetroot.

Step 6: Stems

Paint the stems of your beetroot using 'burgundy'.

Step 7: Add detail

Add details to the root, leaves and stems. Build up depth, layer by layer. The more layers, the more rich your final result will be.

NOTE: Use a hairdryer to dry layers faster.

Step 8: Splatter!

Create a "splatter" effect by painting small green circles near your leaves. Then tap a wet, loaded brush just above the paper to generate splatter. Repeat the splatter process in red next to the beetroot for a contemporary look.
