



# Play based Learning: Sensory Creating - Build a 3D House

## Take your child on a sensory development adventure!

- promote abstract thinking through creation;
- encourage sensory development;
- develop fine motor skills; and
- promote imaginative play and emotional expression.

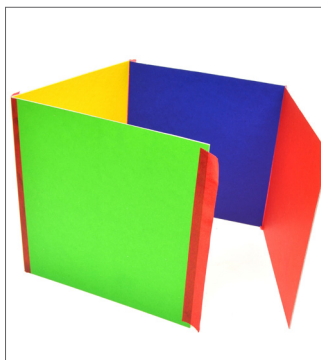
Children who are ready for a more guided activity to complement their sensory play will enjoy creating this 3D house by following the steps below!

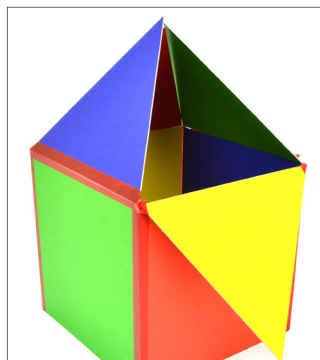


## Let's start...



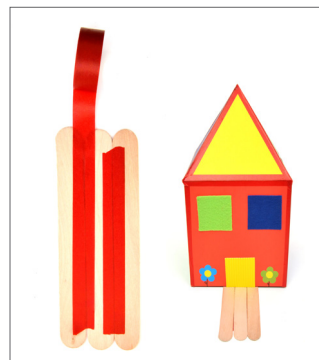
### 1. Create the base

Line up the 4 square cards and tape together along the edges to make the base of the house.



### 2. Secure the roof

Create a pyramid for the roof by taping along the edges of the triangles and then taping the bottom edge of the pyramid to the top of the base of the house.



### 3. Produce a path

To make the path, tape three craft sticks together. Flip over so you cannot see the tape and secure to the base of the house with more tape.



### 4. Decorate!

Decorate the house using the felt and card shapes for the doors and windows. You can also use the stickers to add flowers to the front of the house.



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
